Sacroiliac Joint Injections

The SI Joint is a firm joint that is located at the junction of the spine and pelvis. Sacroiliac joint inflammation can cause pain to the left or the right side of your lower back. The pain may radiate into the buttocks or groin. Sacroiliac injections allow us to directly inject a strong anti-inflammatory medication (STEROID) and a local anesthetic into the affected joint. This helps to reduce swelling and inflammation and allows the joint to heal. The goal is to help promote comfort and relief from these symptoms.
